Residential trips

As you may be aware, we currently offer residential trips to our year 5 and year 6 children.

These visits are incredibly worthwhile for the children both from a curriculum viewpoint and from a personal and social viewpoint. The children always return from our residential visits more independent, confident and socially aware; they are invaluable.

In September 2023 our year 5 and year 6 children travelled together to the PGL Centre Bawdsey Manor, Suffolk. A similar trip will take place again in September 2025 when current year 4 are in year 6.

Next academic year we will be returning to Malham Cove, near Skipton in North Yorkshire, which provides a wealth of opportunities for geographical study and outdoor pursuits. We have delivered this residential visit previously and it has always been an incredibly successful and beneficial trip for all the children.

The residential trip will take place from Tuesday morning, 24th September to Friday early evening, 27th September 2024.

We intend to hold a meeting in school on <u>Wednesday 24th January at 6:00p.m</u>. to provide an outline of the trip, details of activities, accommodation and costings and payment details. Following the meeting we will then require parents to commit to their child participating in the residential visit. **Both children and parents are welcome to attend the meeting.**

We would strongly advise all parents to attend so that they can make an informed decision about whether their child would like to go on the residential.
