Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very pleased with the way the morning library sessions have previously worked and plan to continue to run them during this academic year.

We understand that not everyone will be able to join us on every occasion, but it is hoped that over time all adults will have the opportunity to share in this activity. The day of the week for each class will change, after a period of time, to allow parents who work on certain days of the week to participate.

Children whose parents/grandparents/child minder/family are unable to attend will be directed to the library when they come into school and will be able to share a book with either a member of staff or an older child.

We hope this will provide an opportunity for family members to come into school to read a story with your child. So that time can be spent sharing a book, this will not be the time to change library books. The class teacher will be in the library supervising children and so we ask that if you have a concern you wish to raise, an appointment is made at a more convenient time.

The invitation is to bring your child into the school library from 8:35am. This should be via the usual entrance into school taken by your child, this will allow them to hang up their coat/bags etc. before making your way to the library. The session will end at approximately 8:50am as directed by the class teacher.

We ask that parents sign in and out on a sheet that will be in the library.

We hope the sessions continue to be well supported and look forward to seeing you sharing books with your child and welcoming you into the school.
