Dear Parents/Carers,

4th September 2024

Your child will be swimming with the school as from **TUESDAY 10th SEPTEMBER** and for every Tuesday for the next two terms, the last session will be 3rd December. **The cost is £4 per week which will partially cover the cost of the transport and swimming instruction. If you would prefer you can pay one sum of £48 to cover the two terms** but we cannot offer any refunds if your child is unable to swim for any reason.

The Spalding Swimming Pool have asked us to remind parents of the Health and Safety requirements of the pool and have made it clear that unless they are adhered to, the children will not be allowed in the pool.

The pool requires that:

- Conventional swimming costumes must be worn. Swimming trunks for boys (not board shorts), a one-piece costume for girls.
- **Swimming hats must be worn by all children.**
- Swim vests are only worn for specific medical reasons as they can hinder performance in the water.
- No jewellery whatsoever is to be brought to the pool (including earrings). If a child has religious jewellery that can be worn, it may be worn underneath the swimming hat, not around the neck, to ensure safety of wearers and other swimmers.

Particularly with younger children, we should be very grateful if the correct money could be sent in a sealed envelope marked with the child's name, and that all items are named and brought in a suitable sized bag.

The children should not bring any spending money, or shower items, talcum powder etc.

Whilst the children can bring goggles with them, they will be actively encouraged to swim without them and we would appreciate your support with this.

In respect of children who have not been swimming with this school before, please would you let the class teacher know if your child has achieved any swimming certificates, i.e. 5/10 metres.
