Nature of support 2013/14

The pupil premium funding has been used to fund a range of initiatives within the school. These have been:

Teaching assistants have been employed to deliver intervention programmes to groups of children.

Funding is available to provide targeted teacher intervention for groups of children in Y6.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2013/14

The progress made by children has been identified as a key area for development within the school development plan. As part of this development those children in receipt of pupil premium funding are being closely tracked and targeted intervention provided where necessary.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

Impact at the end of 2012/13

Children are tracked for the progress they make each year. The table below summaries the average progress made by children who triggered the pupil premium funding during 2012/13, for that academic year. The figures show the average points score progress for each group of children. The average progress expected for children over a year is 3 points.

There were two children in year 6 who were eligible for the funding. One child joined the school in December 2012. The levels achieved by these children were as follows:
