Item	Outcomes
Swimming provision in school	Y6 were assessed and those who were unable to swim 25m were provided with extra swimming lessons. By the time Y6 children left the school 73% were able to swim 25m.
Sports games provision – competitions and travel	The school continued to take part in many sports competitions and enjoyed many successes for example winning county hockey.
Playground leader course	Took place and this year (2014/15) is being implemented.
Support for PE leader	Risk assessments, policy etc. in place through support from RG.
Release time for PE leader, 1 hour over 7 weeks	Yes and the impact of this contributed to the organisation of the school sports events and the successful awarding of the silver kite mark.
Release time for team teaching yr 5/6 gymnastics	A limited number of these took place and more are planned for this year – this helped the sports leader to form judgements upon training needs for 2014/15.
Inter school competitions	For the first time these took place and were a requirement for the awarding of the silver kite mark.
Equipment, benches, playground kits, hockey resources etc	These resources support the delivery of PE lessons.
Gifted & Talented provision	The club took place with 12 children taking part from Y3/4/5 – multi skills to promote physical development and tactical awareness.
Sports Week	These took place and were enjoyed by the children – all

provision of accessible sport	children took part.
Management allowance for sports leader	This has been a very successful year for sport at The John Harrox Primary School with increased participation in sport both competitive and non-competitive. Leadership roles in sport have also been promoted. This development can be seen in the successful awarding of the Silver Kite Mark for the school.
