Nature of support 2018/19

The pupil premium funding has been used to fund a range of initiatives within the school. These have been:

Teaching assistants have been employed to deliver intervention programmes to groups of children and provide support through normal classroom activities.

Funding is available to provide targeted teacher intervention for groups of children in Y6.

Some children receive support in the contribution to the cost of school trips.

Additional LAC funding has been used for music lessons and to purchase a laptop computer.

Support services from outside agencies may also be bought by the school.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2018/19

The school development plan identifies maths as a key subject area for improvement. All children's progress is closely tracked and required support identified. The school is also implementing a new maths scheme and teaching assistant support in maths has been prioritised. In addition, maths intervention programmes have also been prioritised.
