

Online Safety Progression

Online safety will be explicitly taught during Spring Term 1. This is the term where children are most likely to receive new technology, therefore, it is essential that we reinforce safety messages whilst using technology.

Common Sense Media follows 6 main strands of online safety, of which our progression will teach a minimum of one lesson per strand, per cycle.
