<u>Activity 1</u> Science (States of matter unit)	I can investigate solubility using household object	Can you test 6 different household items eg salt, sugar, coffee to find out which is soluble and which is insoluble. Attached is the method for the experiment.  Once the experiment is complete you must write your investigation and present your findings as a table.  **Extension** can you change any of the variables (e.g temperature, volume of water used) to help solubility in those substances that are insoluble?
<u>Activity 2</u> History & Art (The Romans)	To create a mosaic based on an important Roman event.	Research a particular event in Roman history and create a mosaic that symbolise this. Use the attached power point to research mosaics. I have attached some worksheets for you to draw your mosaic on however if you would prefer to print your mosaic using paint or make a stencil this would be great.
<u>Activity 3</u> PE (Dance)	To create a dance depicting a roman soldier travelling to battle then their movements during battle.	Remember to use what you have learnt about the Roman army to help you with this (eg. Was their armour heavy? Would it affect the way they move?) . Choose some appropriate music to dance too. If an adult at home is available to help you it would be great to see some of your creations.
