Item	Outcomes	
Swimming provision in school	Y6 were assessed and those who were unable to swim 25m were provided with extra swimming lessons. By the time Y6 children left the school 73% were able to swim 25m.	
Sports games provision – competitions and travel	The school continued to take part in many sports competitions and enjoyed many successes for example winning county hockey.	
Playground leader course	Took place and this year (2014/15)is being implemented.	
Support for PE leader	Risk assessments, policy etc. in place through support from RG.	
Release time for PE leader, 1 hour over 7 weeks	Yes and the impact of this contributed top the organisation of the school sports events and the successful awarding of the silver kite mark.
